By Road – The Tweed Coast is located 824km north of Sydney and 122km south of Brisbane along the Pacific Highway.

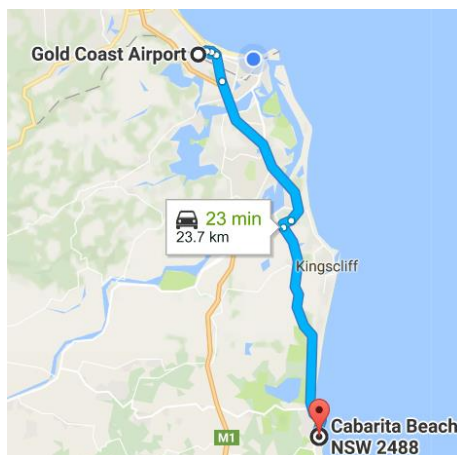
By Air – The Gold Coast International Airport offers direct flights from all States and is located approximately 20 minutes South of Cabarita Beach which will be the central location for the event:

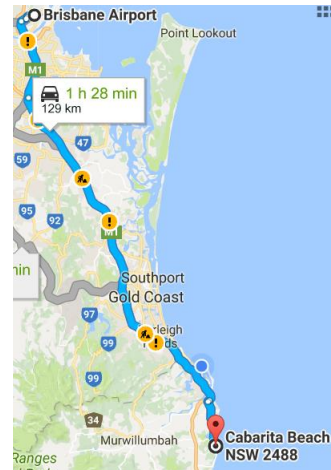

Possible competition venues;

The Tweed has 37km of stunning coastline and is home to a number of great beach break and point options that work in a variety of wind and swell conditions. The main base for the event will be Cabarita Beach which is located 20min South of Coolangatta. The event is fully mobile on the Tweed Coast with numerous beach break competition options which include some of the best surf spots on the east coast including; Durambah Beach, Letitia Spit, Fingal Point, Fingal Beach, Kingscliff Beach, South Kingscliff Beach, Casuarina Beach, Cabarita Beach, South Cabarita Beach, Hastings Point, South Hastings Point, Pottsville Beach, Wooyung Beach.

Conditions and water temps;

All event options offer a variety of peaky beach breaks that work in a variety of conditions. Expect sand bottomed waves in the 2-4 foot range but swells 4 feet+ are possible. Expect water temps approx 19-22 C depending on ocean currents. 2mm Short or long sleeve Steamers are recommended although spring suits or board shorts with a vest can be an option for the brave.

Accommodation;

The Tweed Coast boasts a large selection of hotels, motels, holiday and caravan parks, resorts, Air B&Bs and self-contained accommodation. It is recommended that Competitors and families stay from Coolangatta in the North to Pottsville in the South to stay within 20 – 30 minutes of the likely competition venues.
